What is the At-Home Learning Centre?

We are an online, public school where all instruction occurs in a synchronous format. Synchronous means in real time, with classes being conducted by a teacher providing live instruction and interacting with students as they learn. Just like a traditional classroom!

Created to meet the immediate needs of our communities during the COVID-19 crises, AHLC offers families the option to learn at home while remaining connected to the larger public school community.

Our main office is located in High Level, however we serve students throughout Fort Vermilion School Division. This includes the communities of **Rainbow Lake, High Level, Meander River, Rocky Lane, Fort Vermilion, La Crete, Buffalo Head Prairie, Blue Hills** and all rural areas between.



Online Advantage

There are many advantages to the online format offered by AHLC.

- ▶ **Instruction happens in real time** and follows the Alberta Education curriculum.
- ▶ **Flexibility!** Lessons are recorded and available to students so when life happens your child can stay caught up.
- ▶ **Live instruction from certified teachers.** Gr 1-6 have dedicated homeroom teachers covering the four core courses including Health and PhysEd. Gr 7, 8 & 9 have two teachers: an LA/Social Studies/ Phys Ed teacher, and a Math/ Science teacher.
- ▶ **GoGuardian** allows teachers to monitor student screens, help troubleshoot issues and open or close tabs to keep students on task. Teachers can also turn mics on/off through the meeting platform as necessary during instruction time.
- ▶ Connection to 'Home School' is maintained for students who have transferred from another FVSD school. **Assessments and IPP's follow the student,** AHLC teachers work closely with past teachers to ensure supports and plans are maintained and tailored to the new delivery model.
- ▶ Students learning below grade level have the opportunity to learn at their current level without feeling singled out. **Teachers are able to conduct assessments and facilitate connections to programs as required.**

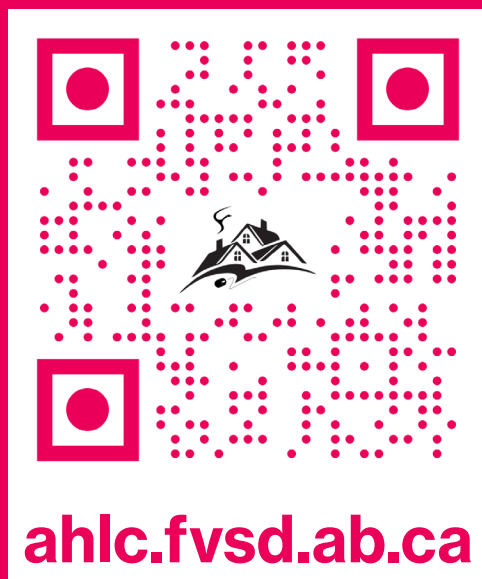
